Background/Purpose

A follow-up from the induction meeting in Murang'a County. Further insights sought through data synthesis of Murang'a County key performance indicators in MNH. An analysis of the last KDHS (2022) was undertaken, and a comparison was made with the 2024/2025 data. This was weighed against the EWENE targets and milestones. The CEC Health had given an overview at the induction meeting of the strides Murang'a County had made in increasing the resilience of the health system, which richly informed the development of the situation analysis.

Objectives of the Activity

1. Key performance indicators related to the EWENE targets and milestones and national targets.
2. MPDSR, conducted on Tuesdays in the County provides a nidus for addressing gaps in the reduction of maternal and neonatal mortality.
3. The WHO Quality Framework gives aspects for the quality improvement team to address.
4. Interrogation of the acceleration plan pillars.
